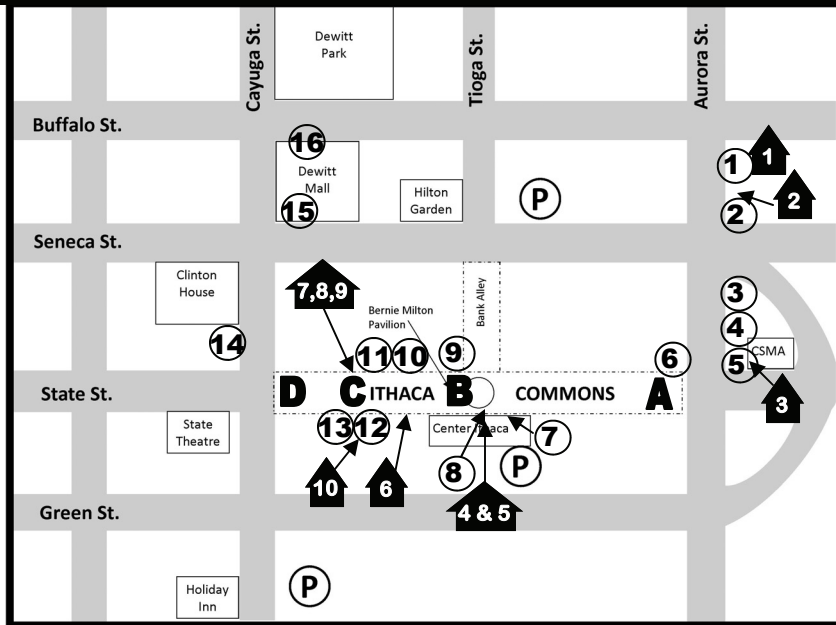

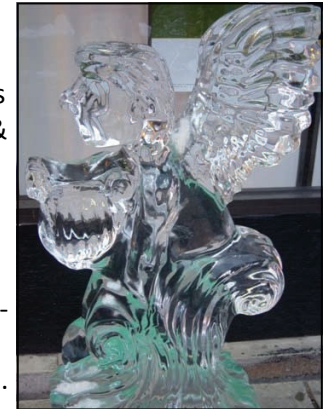
Downtown Ithaca's Holiday Festival Schedule
